The prime event Industrial Forum was organized vibrantly by the IEEE Madras Section at VIT, Chennai on 22nd February 2020. THEME: Future of Technology Management

On 22nd February morning the students from various Institutes after completing their registration gathered at the Conference Hall of Academic Block 1 in VIT, Chennai along with the distinguished speakers of the day. Mrs. Vydeki, the IEEE SB Counselor of VIT, Chennai started the forum with a welcome note. The Forum was inaugurated by Dr. Kulanthaivel, Chair, IEEE TEMS Madras Chapter. During his speech he spoke on the importance of Industrial Forum and the benefits getting involved in it. Dr. Sudeenra Koushik, Chair IEEE TEMS India was the first speaker of the day. He gave the overview of IEEE TEMS and its impact across the globe. He shared his experience with the crowd and inspired the students to involve themselves in various volunteering works. Following his inspirational talk there was a short tea break, which was a great time for the students to meet their peers and industrialists and expand their network. The post lunch session was based on opportunities for consultants for the Engineering communities by Mr. K U Srinivasan, Principle Consultant. The essential topic of today's world "Future Education and Technology" was covered by Mr. Rajendran Dandapani, Dean Zoho University.
