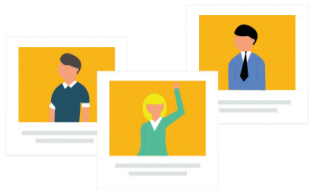
STUDENT CONGRESS:

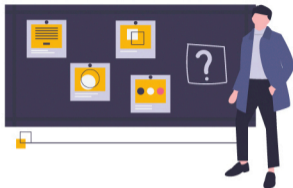
