SSIT– Who we are, a blog contest and how to join!

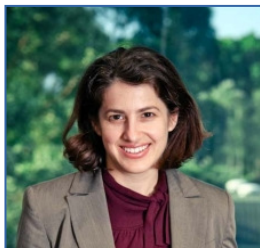

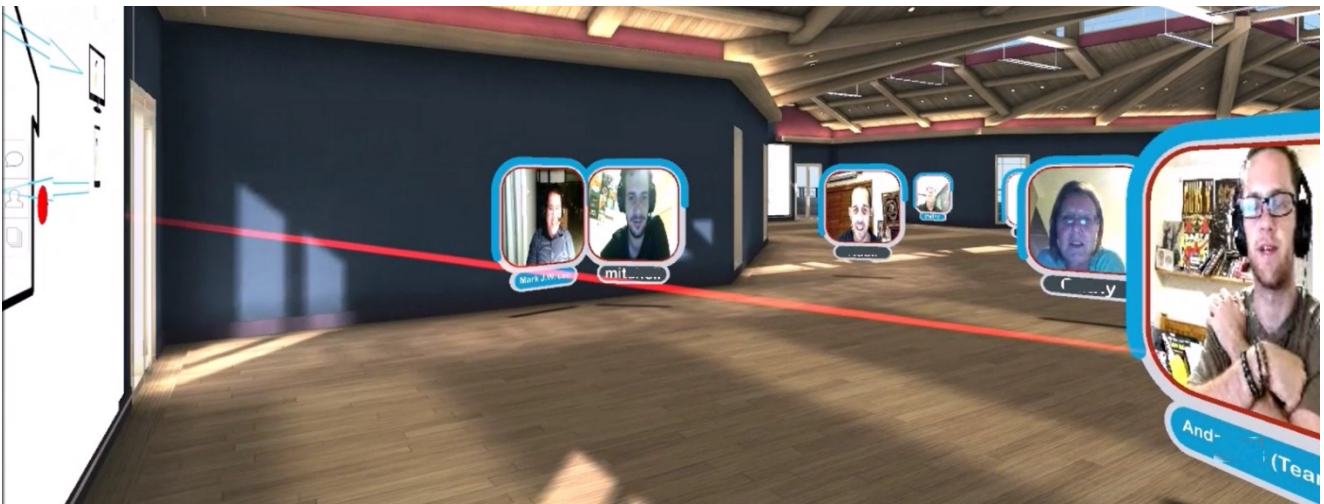
Education Chapter Update

April:

Students from a UOW third year project based subject were required to pitch their favourite idea to the audience in a trade show styled environment. The audience consisted of students from the Dubai campus, enrolled in the same subject as well as industry guests and staff. The goal of the audience was to provide feedback and identify any positives or negatives to aid the team before they did a pitch to an academic panel.

The advantage of iSee compared to other Multi User Virtual Environments (MUVE) is that it is video based. This means you get to see the facial expressions of the people you are speaking to.

A number of casual academic teaching staff, outlined their strategies for engaging students and facilitating learning. ICPADM 2015 to be held in Sydney, July 19-22.

ICPADM 2015 (International Conference on the Properties and Applications of Dielectric materials) is the IEEE's only Asia-Pacific high voltage insulation and dielectric materials conference. It is a major triennial conference and was first held the IEEE in Xi'an in 1985. It is being held in Australia this year at the University of NSW and is being organised by the newly formed NSW Chapter of the IEEE Dielectrics and Electrical Insulation Society.

It will be held at UNSW on July 19-22 of 2015. Thus far about 200 attendees have registered and will be delivering a total of 272 papers, made up of 128 oral papers in 21 sessions and 144 poster presentations in five sessions. Five plenary keynote review papers by internationally recognised experts from China, Japan, Italy and the UK will be presented. The Professor Liu Ziyu Memorial Lecture will be presented by Prof Li Shengtao of *Xi'an Jiaotong University* and the Chinese *State Key Laboratory of Electrical Insulation and Power Equipment*.

Future IoT may bring us an era of “harmony of man with nature”, which means a harmonious fusion of Physical-space, Cyber-space, and Social-space. We will witness an emancipation not only from onerous physical labor, replaced by machine-human interface, but also from the spatial-temporal constraints of Physical-space, and will achieve substantial benefits from IT development.

The 2015 IEEE International Conference on Internet of Things (iThings2015) will provide a high-profile, leading-edge forum for researchers, engineers, and practitioners to present state-of-art advances and innovations in theoretical foundations, systems, infrastructure, tools, testbeds, and applications for the Internet of Things, as well as to identify emerging research topics and to define the future.
