6.3	Treasurer	 Rob advised the meeting that details of the finances could be found in the AGM Report. Electronic banking has been set up for the bank accounts. The accounts require two people to authorise a transaction. Currently Daniel Eghbal (incoming Chair) and Rob Kennedy (Treasurer) can authorise transactions. The meeting unanimously agreed that Nilesh Modi (incoming Vice-chair) and Tapan Saha should also be able to authorise transactions to cover times when people are on leave, sick, etc. Some items highlighted by Rob included: The opening balance of the Access Account was \$13,040.06 on 1 December 2015, and the closing balance was \$6,849.01 on 11 November 2016. A new \$10,000 term deposit account was opened in 2016, bringing the total value of term deposits to over \$120,000. The main expense items were the same as last year with student activities, AGM, meeting catering and student prizes. Chapter expenses were a little more than last year at just over \$7,200. Rob is in communication with Jianguo Huang (R10 Professional Activities Coordinator) re paying for an event organised by Dian Tjondronegoro.
