5 Committee Coordination

5.1 Section issues (Chair)

5.1.1 RAB/TAB Visit – Michael Evans Australia Council chairman wrote an e-mail which was attached to the agenda. A number of cities were to be visited by the RAB/TAB and the possible dates of arrival in Brisbane are the 4th or 5th of December. Tapan asked what the interest was from the Queensland Section to host these groups in Brisbane. However, Tapan also added that he will not be in Brisbane on those dates and Peter Sutton and Joe Dong also indicated that they would be away at those dates. It was agreed that the section would be interested in hosting the groups, however these dates are not suitable for the visit to Brisbane.

5.2 Financial issues (Treasurer)

- 5.2.1 The rebate has been received for the year 2004. Amoakoh suggested that more need to apply for senior members, as senior members bring in more funds. He also stated that Affinity group meetings (GOLD etc) attract \$200 per meeting. Peter Sutton said that 5 chapters had Affinity group meetings in 2004 which gathered \$1000.
- 5.2.2 No update on signatories issue for the section account. Peter Sutton to look into this. It was suggested that some money from the account be put into a fixed interest account, possibly 50%, and keep the rest in the normal account. Peter Sutton and Tapan to sort out signatories and also look into the options for the fixed interest account.
- 5.2.3 The Queensland Section have paid the funds that Tapan requested in previous meetings regarding the flights/accommodation etc for the section congress in Florida. Section 10 will be reimbursing these funds at a later date.
- 5.2.4 Joaquin raised the point that the section should have a discussion on how to use the money in the section account. He suggested that these funds be used as a catalyst for section activities. Vallipuram Muthukkumarasamy suggested that it could be used for some student scholarships but Peter Sutton said that the section is not allowed to use such money on scholarships. Both Vallipuram Muthukkumarasamy and Joaquin suggested that the money could be used for prizes to encourage student membership. It was also suggested that such prizes incorporate the subsidy of the winning students IEEE membership fees. Tapan is to send out an e-mail regarding this issue and the section is to consider options for prizes or subsidising memberships in order to attract undergraduate student members. This is to be an item of discussion in the next meeting.
