- 1.2 Meeting chaired by Vaughan (present @UQ). Minutes taken by Abbas.

#### Attachment 1 Boundary between Queensland & NQ Sections

Dear committee

For at least a year, NQ Section has been wanting to revise/update/clarify the 'boundary' between Qld & NQ Section. Our bylaws state in Section 2 that

The territory of the Queensland Section, as approved by RAB, includes that portion of the state of Queensland, Australia between the Tropic of Capricorn and the New South Wales border, plus all of Rockhampton. The section includes those areas of Queensland with postcodes 4000 -

all of Rockhampton. The section includes those areas of Queensland with post 4739; 9008; and 9726.

The first part is not in dispute. The mapping to/from postcodes is the tricky bit. This is really the only way that IEEE HQ can sort members into Sections (since we don't usually provide the latitude & longitude of our home address). I think NQ Section is concerned that they are not getting all the postcodes/members that are due to them.

Last year, it was discussed at the Qld Section execom. It was resolved that Qld Section would take no action until NQ Section provided a postcode map clearly showing how the proposed postcodes matched our understanding that Qld Section = sub-tropical Qld + Rocky.

Now, NQ Section has a new proposal: that we should ask IEEE HQ to sort members into Qld or NQ Sections according to Australia Post's own 'Print Post Sort Plan':

Specifically, NQ's proposal is that all postcodes that would be routed through the Cairns, Townsville or Mackay Mail Centres (PreSort Indicators 459, 460 and 466) should be NQ members, all others should be Qld members.

I think this might be a fair plan. I also believe we should revise our by-laws to omit any mention of postcodes, since that description is changeable at Australia Post's whim.

Anyway, I'd like to flag this as something for discussion/resolution at next Tuesday's meeting. Abbas, could you put it on the agenda, please?
