The treasurer (Mike Robinson) to inform the bank ASAP.</li> <li>Activity bonus: In an effort to encourage activities at the local level, activity bonuses may be awarded as follows:</li> <li>All sections reporting ten meetings or more, at least five of which must be of a technical nature, shall receive an additional US\$200.</li> <li>All subsections reporting ten meetings or more, at least five of which must be of a technical nature, shall receive an additional US\$100.</li> <li>Joint meetings may be counted toward only one unit's bonus. For example, joint meetings of different chapters and/or affinity groups may not be counted as a meeting for both units.</li> <li>All chapters or affinity groups reporting six or more meetings shall receive an additional US\$75; in the case of a chapter, at least six of the reported meetings shall be in the technical category.</li> <li>Activity bonus funds are excluded from the 10% bonus for timely reporting.</li> <li>All units must qualify for the timely reporting bonus (see #5 above) in order to be eligible for an activity bonus.</li> </ul>
