6.1	Chair	 As advised previously, the IEEE has an International Registration Project underway. This involves setting up Companies "Limited by Guarantee" in various countries including Australia. We have been informed that the Australian company would act as a legal shield to protect organizers of IEEE events from being liable for (say) an attendee breaking their arm. It is envisaged that the company's board would comprise IEEE Section Chairs. That is, the IEEE Section Chairs, who are members of the IEEE Australia Council, would have increased responsibilities. A summary of a recent teleconference that was attended by the International Registration Project team members and Australia Council members was sent to all members by email. A tentative organizational structure was also attached. It may take over a year to establish the Australian company. It is envisaged that all Australian section accounts will be transferred to the Australian company's bank (with Sections having individual account numbers). At the above-mentioned meeting we were informed that IEEE Headquarters would pay for the cost of the Australian company's setup and operating costs (including legal accounting costs). It is possible that future Section income from the IEEE may flow through the proposed organizational structure.
